Doesn't belong in the used glass container:

- Sheets of glass (e.g. window panes or mirrors)
- Ceramics, porcelain
- Fire-resistant glass

For emptied packaging materials only

Synthetic packaging materials

- Plastic bottles: e.g. for hair shampoo, detergents
- Plastic wrappers and bags, e.g. for sweets
- Plastic pots: e.g. for dairy products

Metal packaging materials

- Tins, food cans
- Aluminum packaging materials
- Metal lids from food jars

Drink cartons

Milk and juice cartons



Doesn't belong in the biowaste container:

- Cooked food leftovers

Doesn't belong in the waste paper bin:
